

# Alphabetized glossary German-English

Here is a short introduction for you on how to use the glossaries:

The words in blue are particularly important, because they are high frequency words, meaning that they are the ones you will need in order to communicate. Thus, they need to become your active vocabulary. Make sure you memorize them, e.g. **hallo**

The underlined vowel means that this vowel is stressed. You have to pronounce this vowel long, e.g. **du**

A dot means that the vowel is stressed but short, e.g. **hallo**

A bar behind a syllable indicates that the verb is separable, e.g. **an|rufen**

Names and numbers are not listed here.

In the alphabetized glossaries, the numbers behind the word indicate in which chapter and on which page you find the word.
