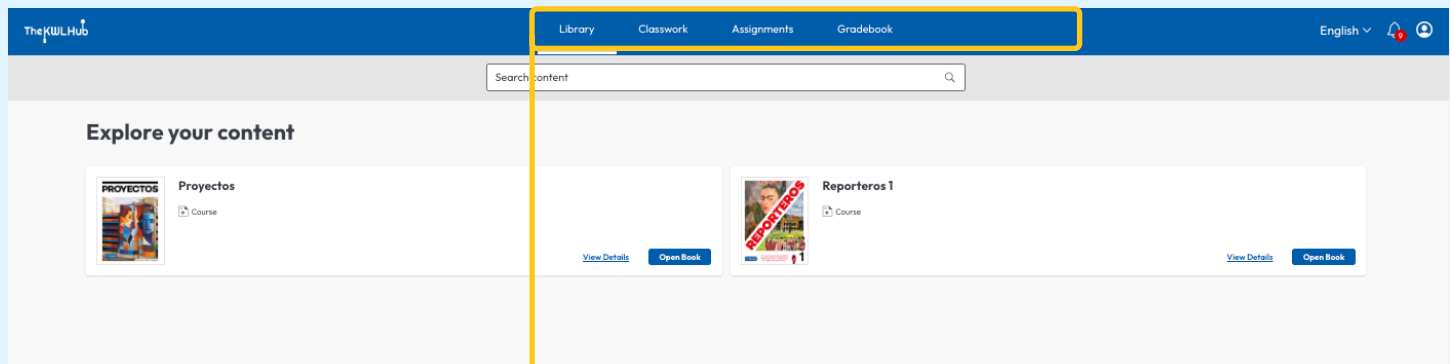

Getting Started

A quick overview to help you navigate the platform and find what you need.

Library (Home)

After signing in, you land on **Library**, your home dashboard.



The **top navigation menu** provides access to:

- 1 **Library** – Access your courses.
(see Course View on the next page).
- 2 **Classwork** – View upcoming and completed assignments and sort them by due date.
- 3 **Assignments** – View upcoming, missing, submitted, and graded assignments.
- 4 **Gradebook** – View graded assignments and track performance by score.

Inside Course View

Opening a book takes you to Course View, where all materials are organized in one place.



The **left-hand panel** organizes all course materials in one place:

- 1 **eBooks** – Digital versions of the Student Edition and Workbook with hotspots that provide direct access to audio, video, and additional resources.
- 2 **Interactive Versions (Student & Workbook)** – Assignable digital activities with built-in tools.
- 3 **Self-Check Quizzes** – Short, auto-graded formative checks for grammar and vocabulary.
- 4 **Interactive “My Progress” Sheets** – A self-assessment section where students review their progress on the unit’s communicative objectives and identify areas for improvement.
- 5 **Resources** – Audios, tutorials, worksheets, and student support materials.
- 6 **Authentic Resource Bank** – Additional cultural materials (where available).

Available resources may vary by program. For this overview, Reporteros 1 is used as an example.
